

## **Dual Enrollment Courses**

Dual enrollment courses, taught on the TFS campus, allow students to earn both high school and college credit. The Dual Enrollment Act, otherwise known as House Bill 444, altered the funding formula to allow only 30 hours for high school students taking dual enrollment coursework in the state of Georgia. Students interested in dual enrollment must meet the SAT/ACT requirements for the University System of Georgia. TFS employs instructors who meet the SACS qualifications to teach college courses.
