- Supervises, evaluates, trains and recruits assistant basketball coaches
- Coordinates scheduling in conjunction with the boys basketball head coach for all teams in the girls program
- Coordinates in conjunction with boys basketball coach specific home basketball game theme nights (i.e. MS Night, Staff Appreciation Night, etc.)
- Conducts pre- and post-season meetings with player personnel and all coaches and staff
- Plans and implements summer development opportunities for returning players
- Plans and implements a youth basketball summer camp
