## ACCOMPLISHMENTS

## COLLEGE-BOUND PLAYERS

## FACILITIES & TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES

The baseball program plays its home games at the Higgins Baseball Complex on the Upper School campus. The varsity/JV field is 365 feet in the gaps, and the backdrop beyond the fence from center to right field is a rock staircase. The complex has an indoor hitting facility, and the brand new middle school baseball field sits back behind that. The season runs from February through May, and players have access to TFS weight rooms/fitness centers, and field and hitting facility access in the off-season.
