ACCOMPLISHMENTS

The bass fishing team has had great success in its infancy, including finishing 8th at the Georgia Bass Nation state championships in 2020, and having an 11th-place team in 2022.

The program has featured a recent grad, Marshall Williams, earning Positive Athlete status for the state of Georgia. The team competes in roughly eight tournaments during the academic year in the Georgia Bass Nation Tournament.
