DUAL ENROLLMENT COURSES

Dual enrollment courses, taught on the TFS campus, allow students to earn both high school and college credit. The Dual Enrollment Act, otherwise known as House Bill 444, altered the funding formula for high school students in the state of Georgia taking dual enrollment starting the 2021-2022 school year. Students interested in dual enrollment must meet the SAT/ACT requirements for the University System of Georgia. TFS employs instructors that meet the SACS qualifications to teach college courses. For the 2023-2024 school year, TFS has one Advanced Placement course taught in person and 14 online AP courses. Texts and syllabi are provided by the colleges.
