## ACADEMIC INFORMATION

Tallulah Falls School operates on a two semester schedule with exams at the conclusion of each semester. All academic courses are offered as college preparatory, honors level, or dual enrollment college courses.

- Weighted GPAs are calculated according to the GPA weighting policy below, which is also included on the TFS transcript.

## DUAL ENROLLMENT & AP COURSES

Dual enrollment courses, taught on the TFS campus, allow students to earn both high school and college credits. The Dual Enrollment Act, otherwise known as House Bill 444, altered the funding formula for high school students in the state of Georgia taking dual enrollment starting the 2021-2022 school year. Students interested in dual enrollment must meet the SAT/ACT requirements for the University System of Georgia. TFS employs instructors that meet the SACS qualifications to teach college courses. Texts and syllabi are provided by the colleges. For the 2024-2025 school year, TFS has three Advanced Placement courses taught in person and thirteen online AP courses.
