VISITORS Game Day Protocol

(Last revised 11-4-20)



Welcome VISITING SPECTATORS! We are glad to have you! To best facilitate the safety of the athletes playing under our facility, please adhere to the following guidelines.

- Limited to two spectators per player on the roster and visiting team coach's spouse.
- **All spectators are required to wear a face-covering in the gym.**
- The visiting coach or AD must provide a roster with the names of the two persons attending the game to Lowell Hamilton lowell.hamilton@tallulahfalls.org 24 hours in advance, preferably sooner. This roster should come from the coach or AD. Do not have parents/spectators contact TFS.
- All fans will be required to complete a temperature screening upon entering the gym lobby and will be allowed entry only if showing no symptoms of being sick.
- Follow the entry and exit paths, reduce travel, and please do not congregate inside or outside the gym or lobby.
- Please adhere to physical distancing requirements in spectator areas.
- TFS is a tobacco-free campus
- Restroom spacing allows for two at a time
- A face mask will be required if physical distancing is not possible while on the bench.
- Please have your players bring their own water bottles. Visiting teams may bring a cooler of water for their team, but TFS will provide a cooler of water for bottles to be refilled.
- **JV Boys & Girls basketball will play at the high school gym and will not be able to enter the gym until 3:15 PM (201 Campus Drive) unless otherwise indicated differently.**
- The JV boys visiting team (while waiting to play) will be housed in the Circle Building lobby and will be able to watch JV girls play via NFHS Network Streaming from a monitor.
- **SPECTATORS for boys JV must arrive 15min before the start of their scheduled game (please do not arrive before 15min before that scheduled time). *There is a stairwell that takes you up to the gym when it's time for your game to start.***
- Varsity Girls & Boys will play at the MS Student Activity Center gym (295 Tallulah Gorge Scenic Loop). The Boy's VARSITY visiting team (while waiting to play) will have space upstairs to view the varsity girls game from above (or a private room will be provided to watch from a monitor).
- **Visiting Boy's varsity SPECTATORS must arrive at the gym no sooner than 15 minutes before the scheduled start time of the boys game. This allows time for varsity girl's SPECTATORS to leave the gym before the boy's varsity SPECTATORS arrives.**

Tickets

- Tickets are sold through <https://gofan.co/app/tickets> and are \$5/adult, \$3 per child/student for all high school games
Middle school games are \$3 / \$1
- NOTE: there are no free tickets for any age
- SEASON PASS for adults HS Home Games is \$50.00 (a \$10.00 discount)/ Under 18 \$30.00 / MS Home Game Pass is \$21.00 (a \$6.00 discount)

Concessions

- Limited concessions will be sold (drinks, packaged goods)
- Please do not congregate in the lobby

TFS will

- Provide hand sanitizer for both schools and officials
- Temperatures will be screened via a kiosk for everyone as they enter the gym lobby
- Provide a sanitized game ball to officials in their dressing room before the game
- Sanitize game balls using GHSA recommendation by Wilson / BTC 2125 M 10% solution (EPA # 1839-86)
- Sanitize official scores table pregame and halftime
- **Visiting teams will have an assigned locker room; please coordinate dressing/physical distancing**

GHSA Game Day Protocols:

- The pre-game conference is limited to one coach, one player/captain from each team, and the official(s), all the while maintaining physical distancing.
- No handshakes before or after matches.
- Rosters shall be submitted directly to the official's table before or at the beginning of the pre-game warm-up
- Team bench/chairs will be spaced for 6ft distancing/face mask must be worn on the bench
- Officials table and ball will be sanitized before and at halftime
- Officials table will be 1 foot further away from the sideline to give more space for substitutions
- Players shall NOT exit the bench area to celebrate with teammates and/or fans.
- Team huddles without physical distancing are prohibited.
- Limit bench personnel to observe physical distancing.
- Players are prohibited from licking, touching any part of their hands to the mouth, or blowing into their hands.
 - NOTE: Any violation of this policy shall be called an "unnecessary delay" immediately, the ball and any equipment shall be sanitized before play resumes.
- Substitutions shall be made with physical distancing to the official(s), scoring table, and other players.
- Limit the Official's Score Table to essential personnel which includes home team Official Bookkeeper, and Scoreboard Operator physical distancing between individuals.
- Visiting team personnel are not deemed essential personnel and will work from an alternate location
- Coaches who request a timeout to discuss a rule shall maintain physical distancing from the official(s).
- Coaches should always maintain physical distance from players and opponents.
