



Tallulah Falls School Soccer Contract

Attention: To participate in the Soccer Program at Tallulah Falls School, the player and their family must read the following and agree to sign this contract. By signing this contract, the signatures will represent an understanding of the procedures set by this program and the expectations set by the coaching staff. The purpose of this contract is to encourage GREAT character and to set a code of accountability for the players. We would like the players to experience and understand the importance of following a system. This system is not just for soccer but to prepare them for life beyond.

EXTRACURRICULAR EXPECTATIONS: All players within this program should adhere to any and all of the Tallulah Falls School policies regarding conduct, integrity and discipline.

PLAYER COMMUNICATION: It is the player's responsibility to communicate to the coaches regarding any issues pertaining to soccer. Parents should allow their children to experience how to communicate to their coaches and how to be responsible for themselves.

ATTITUDE: All players are encouraged to display GREAT character towards their teammates, coaches, opponents, referees, administration, faculty, fans and their peers throughout the entire season. Each player should practice the concept, "We are a TEAM FIRST and an individual second."

ATTENDANCE: All players should attend all practices and team-related events. If an absence is foreseen, then players should display great character by contacting the Coaching Staff at least one day prior to being absent.

PUNCTUALITY: All players are required to be on time for training, games, and any other soccer-related events. All players are to be dressed and ready for

- a. training: 3:00
- b. away match bus loading: check match calendar
- c. home match: 3:00

DRESS CODE for TRAINING: Every player should wear appropriate team-issued shirt, athletic shorts or pants, soccer socks, shin guards, and soccer cleats during training. If a student-athlete attends a training session improperly dressed, then the student-athlete will not be allowed to participate in training. This is to continue uniformity throughout the program.

MATCH DRESS CODE: All players must wear the uniform that is issued at the beginning of the season. Players will only wear the issued soccer kit during the matches unless the coaches deem it necessary to layer for colder games.

TRAVEL: All players travel on the bus to matches. While traveling on the bus, players are encouraged to complete any homework first. Then, they can listen to music or play games on their phones. For music, players should have earbuds so that only they can hear it. If a player is not returning on the bus after a match, then a parent or guardian should find a coach to sign a player out.
