Welcome VISITING PARENT SPECTATORS! We are glad to have you! In order to best facilitate the safety of the girls playing in accordance with our facility, please adhere to the following guidelines.

- Limited to two parents/guardians per player on the roster and visiting team coach's spouse.
- Visiting coach or AD must provide a roster with the names of the two parents/guardians attending to Lowell Hamilton
  <u>lowell.hamilton@tallulahfalls.org</u> 24 hours in advance, preferably sooner.

This roster should come from the coach or AD. Do not have parents contact TFS.

- All tickets are through <u>www.gofan.com</u> (HS = \$5 adults, \$1 all else. Everyone, regardless of age, must have a digital ticket.)
- All fans will be required to wear a face mask while in the gym
- All fans will be required to complete a temperature screening upon entering the gym lobby and are expected to visit only if showing no symptoms of being sick.
- Follow the entry and exit paths, reduce travel and please do not congregate inside or outside
- TFS is a tobacco free campus
- Restroom spacing allows for two at a time
- JV plays at the high school gym (201 Campus Drive). Visiting team playing the 2nd and 3rd games will be housed in the Circle Building lobby (below the gym). There is a stairwell that takes you up to the gym.
- Varsity plays at the MS gym (295 Tallulah Gorge Scenic Loop). VARSITY visiting team AND PARENTS playing the 2nd and 3rd match will have a space upstairs to spread out and view from above.
  - Parents of the varsity team that plays 2nd and 3rd, please enter upstairs through the outside entrance.

## Tickets

- Tickets are sold ONLY through <u>https://gofan.co/app/tickets</u> and are \$5/adult, \$1 per child/student for all high school matches and \$3 adults, \$1 per child/student.
- NOTE: there are no free tickets for any age

## Concessions

- Limited concessions will be sold (drinks, packaged goods)
- Please do not congregate in the lobby

## TFS will

- Provide hand sanitizer for both schools and officials
- Temperature screen via a kiosk everyone as they enter the gym lobby
- Enforce physical distancing requirements in spectator areas
- Provide sanitized game balls and sanitize between matches.
- Sanitize courts, officials table, referee stand, and top and bottom ban of the net between matches.
- Please have your players bring their own water bottles and additional water to refill their water bottles. Visiting teams may bring a cooler of water for their team. Sharing water bottles is prohibited.
- Provide restrooms in a locker room, but the players must arrive in uniform. Locker room restrooms are only meant for that purpose, not for congregating or meeting, and only up to 4 at a time, physically distanced.
- Will provide towels as necessary for a wet floor.

Game Day Protocols (GHSA):

- Pre-match conference is limited to one coach, one player/captain from each team and the official(s), all the while maintaining physical distance.
- No handshakes before or after matches.
- Rosters shall be submitted directly to the official's table before the 10-minute mark.
- Team benches will be clearly marked with tape or spots. No chairs or benches will be allowed in the marked area.
- We ask that teams NOT switch benches during the match and coach's chairs will be sanitized between each match. Two coaches chairs will be provided
- Players shall NOT exit the bench area to celebrate with teammates and/or fans.
- Team huddles without physical distancing are prohibited.
- Limit bench personnel to observe physical distancing.
- Players are prohibited from licking, touching any part of their hands to the mouth, or blowing into their hands.
  - NOTE: Any violation of this policy shall be called an "unnecessary delay" immediately, the ball and any equipment shall be sanitized before play resumes.
- Substitutions shall be made with physical distancing to official(s), scoring table and other players.
- Limit the Official's Table to essential personnel which includes home team scorer, libero tracker and scoreboard operator physical distancing between individuals.
- Visiting team personnel are not deemed essential personnel and will work from an alternate location
- Coaches who request a timeout to discuss a rule, shall maintain physical distancing from the official(s).
- Coaches should always maintain physical distance from players and opponents.
- Line judges will use hand signals no flags. Adults Only.
